Visitor Expectations

- Visitors must **adhere at all times** to the following Core Principles of COVID -19 Infection Prevention.
 - o Visitors who have a positive viral test for COVID-19, symptoms of COVID-19, or currently meet the criteria for quarantine, should not enter the facility. Facilities will screen all who enter for these visitation exclusions;
 - o All visitors must wear a well-fitting non-surgical paper mask or a mask of higher quality (i.e., surgical mask, KN95 or N95) at all times during any visitation at the facility. If the visitor wishes, a cloth mask may be placed over the paper mask. The masks must cover both the nose and the mouth;
 - All visitors must physically distance from facility personnel and other residents/visitors that are not directly associated with the specific resident(s) being visited by that individual.
 - o Hand hygiene (use of alcohol-based hand rub is preferred);
- All Visitors must complete COVID-19 Screening Checklist prior to resident access and visitation will be refused if the individual(s) exhibits any COVID-19 symptoms or do not pass the screening questions and have a temperature of over 100 degrees F;
- Visitors must present a valid negative SARS-CoV-2 test result **one day prior to visitation for antigen tests and two days prior to visitation for NAAT (e.g. PCR) tests**.
- For visitors who visit for multiple days, including a visitor who comes every day, proof of negative testing is required as often as feasible, **at a minimum every third day** (meaning at a minimum testing is required on day one, day 4, day 7, and so on).
- All Visitors must provide: first and last name of the visitor; physical (street) address of the visitor; daytime and evening telephone number; date and time of visit; and email address, if available;
- In room visits should be limited to 2 visitors at a time if the resident has a roommate;
- The facility must limit large gatherings where a large number of visitors are in the same space at the same time and physical distancing cannot be maintained;
- All visitors must limit movement in the facility. Please keep your visit in the resident room or visitation area. Please do not shake hands or visit with other residents. All Visitors must maintain social distancing (6 feet of separation) throughout the visit;
